do you need furniture?

If you need furniture and other household items contact the North Shropshire Furniture Scheme. Anyone can use the scheme, but if you are on a low income or in receipt of benefits then we will only ask you to make a small payment, plus a small delivery charge.

To prove you are on a low income you will need to be referred by one of our referral agencies. This includes: Citizens Advice Bureau, Housing Benefit Department, Council Housing Department, A Housing Association, Social Services, Sure Start, The Job Centre, HOAP Advice Office.

We want to help people improve their living environment and all the items we sell are checked and their suitability for re-use assessed before we allow them into our showroom. For example, any electrical goods need to pass a Portable Appliance Safety Test.

We will collect your unwanted household items

If you have any items of furniture or white goods or anything that might be used in the home that you are thinking of throwing away please contact us.

The North Shropshire Furniture Scheme is a community project that recycles household items and offers them to people on a low income or benefits. There is a small charge for the scheme to collect your donated items.

The scheme aims to help people who have suffered a period of homelessness or people who can't afford large household items improve their living conditions.
